 - Currently, the executive is white (5 women, 7 men).
 - Success for 2021-2022: new Executive nominees are diverse
 - Diversity on CSPB-SCBV committees: 44% women and 17% visible minorities.
- 5. Feeling unwelcome or not included at meetings.
- 6. Childcare needed at AGM.

Accounting

2021-2022 Proposed Budget - revenues




